Show Me Thy Love By Orlan Sawey

In our time we have seen the word love misused woefully by the [world] who says (rightly) that love is the answer to all of humanity's ills. But it is evident that what they mean by love is neither consistent nor clear, ranging from physical passion on the one hand to a tearful sentimentality on the other.

Some in the Lord's church have imitated the [world] asserting (rightly) that love is the center of Christianity, and at the same time confusing Christian love, a priceless virtue, with cheap, tearful sentimentality. James wrote strongly of saving faith, a live faith, not just one which a man says he has, a dead faith (James 2:14-26). Faith, he insisted, can be seen by what we do, and he used feeding and clothing the needy brother and sister as an example of what he meant. Then he wrote, "Yea, a man will say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: show me thy faith apart

from thy works, and I by my works will show thee my faith." Later verses show [plainly that faith apart from works cannot be shown, for it is barren and dead. In like manner, <u>love</u> is shown by what we do. John could easily have said, "Show me thy love!" because love, like faith, can be seen in the life and actions of one who loves. Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7.

John wrote in 1 John 3:13-24 that we ought to love one another, that we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren (Jesus loved us and laid down his life for us). Then he uses the same example that James used as a proof of faith: if we have this world's goods and do not help the brother in need, God's love does not abide in us. Then John writes, "My little children, let us not love in word, neither with the tongue, but in deed and truth." That which is said to be love is not necessarily love. Our love is shown in our lives, by our actions.
